- Rounds:** Saturday: 28 Target Field Round
Sunday: 28 Target Hunter Round
- Styles:** All styles recognised by IFAA rules.
Team event will consist of 4 archers, £4.00 per team, to be nominated **before shooting commences** on 10th of July
- Eligibility:** Members of WFAA, SFAA, EFAA & IFAF are eligible for UK & I of I Championships
Guests may compete for guest awards but they must be a member of an IFAA affiliated body.
- Registration:** Saturday: 8.30am to 10.00am

All entrants must produce a valid membership card at registration.
- Bow Inspection:** Saturday: 9.00am to 10.00am
- Awards:** Championship patches for UK Champions, Gold, Silver and Bronze awards in each division.
Class awards subject to the following ruling: 1 for 1 to 3, 2 for 4 to 6, 3 for 7 to 11. There will be no class awards in A class. Guests may compete for class awards.
- Entry Fees:** Adults - £15.00, Juniors/Cubs - £7.50
