Dear member,

In this Welsh Newsletter you will note the requirement for any member who is or wishes to work with children or vulnerable adults to formally notify the executive committee of this.

Once the committee have been notified that you are or intend to do so, either to coach, train or otherwise work with children or vulnerable adults in the name of or directly in relation to the WFAA and its involvement in field archery with WFAA members you will be sent a form to complete and return. You must complete the Volunteer form and send it to the committee for them to approve prior to commencing any involvement with children or vulnerable adults.

If you do not declare this involvement to the committee, complete the form and gain approval for the activity/contact the WFAA will have to review your ongoing membership.

The WFAA insurance requires us to have a child and vulnerable adult policy that requires this registration and management of any member working with children or vulnerable adults. Please be aware this only applies to contact within the WFAA and in relation to WFAA members.

This requirement does not apply to shooting in a class round or competition with a group that includes children or vulnerable adults on an ad hoc basis.

If you require a Volunteer form please contact any member of the committee as listed in the enclosed magazine.
