Please be aware – On signing this form you are completing a binding agreement for the term of your annual membership with the WFAA to abide by the Rules and Constitution of the WFAA and any or all of the IFAA rules that govern or control Field Archery as an overarching authority to the country associations.

Failure to abide by these, and the rules and constitution of the WFAA, means that you will not be covered by the WFAA Limited Liability insurance.

1. Only equipment that is legally allowed to be used under either WFAA, IFAA rules or the law of the country you are shooting in is allowed to be carried on or at a WFAA site, course or tournament, including practice sessions either formally or informally attended.
2. Adherence to the IFAA Code of Conduct is mandatory at any or all WFAA organised, managed or owned tournaments or organised shoots on any course.
3. All archery equipment will conform to any or all IFAA limitations by way of speed, configuration, manufacture or material. The WFAA reserves the right to check this at any time an archer is present on a WFAA course.
4. No member is permitted to bring a non member onto any WFAA course to shoot unless that person has completed a Temporary membership form in advance and it has been signed by the required committee members.

Please be aware the above rules relates to WFAA membership, the WFAA insurance clearly requires all archers to abide by the rules at any course that has been chartered by the WFAA for the purpose of Field Archery under the WFAA banner or risk not being insured. It is the responsibility of the Club to manage this adherence at their course when shooting under the WFAA insurance.
